For the School Leadership Symposium 2011, it is a pleasure to welcome participants from various countries. Numerous speakers and presenters will provide revealing information and lead interesting discussions.

The conference language is English. The IS will be entirely in English. At the SLS, simultaneous interpretation will be provided for the keynote speeches that are given in German.

Around the Symposium's sessions, there will be a rich offer of cultural and social activities. Additionally, there are the fantastic landscape and the cultural centres of Central Switzerland, with places to see from A as in the "Alps", e.g. the nearby Rigi mountain with its gorgeous view, L as in "Lucerne" with the Music Festival at the beginning of September, and Lake Lucerne (Vierwaldstättersee) with the „Rütliwiese“, where historically Switzerland was founded, to Z as in "Zurich", the business city with its international atmosphere.
